PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food processing equipment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: DO NOT induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

If in Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: DO NOT store near heat or open flame. DO NOT contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these waste cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) the container. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

To Disinfect: Remove gross filth and heavy soil. Prepare a solution by adding 1 ounce of Zepopine-8 to 1 gallon of water. Use this solution and apply by mop, sponge, or spray to clean and disinfect utensils, floors, walls, bedframes, chairs, tables, and bathroom fixtures. Allow a wet contact time of 10 minutes for complete disinfection. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to re-use.

Toilet Bowls: Remove gross filth and heavy soil. Expel residual water over the trap, then scrub entire surface (especially under rim) with a bowl mop using a solution of 1 ounce of Zepopine-8 to 1 gallon of water. Let stand for 10 minutes. Flush and refill bowl.
