


STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

To Disinfect: Remove gross filth and heavy soil. Prepare a solution of 1 ounce of Zepopine-8 to 1 gallon of water. Use this solution and sponge, or spray to clean and disinfect utensils, floors, walls, bed tables, and bathroom fixtures. Allow a wet contact time of 10 minutes for disinfection. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Treated food contact surfaces must be scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to re-use.

Toilet Bowls: Remove gross filth and heavy soil. Expel residual water. Then scrub entire surface (especially under rim) with a bowl mop using 1 ounce of Zepopine-8 to 1 gallon of water. Let stand for 10 minutes. Flush bowl.
