The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to change "Essential Oils" from an active to an inert", is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Revise the referral statement to read:
"See Side Panel for Additional Precautionary Statements"
 - b. Include a contact time for the disinfection section.
 - c. Include the words "and air dry" after the statement "Hold can six inches ... is completely wet".
 - d. Refer to the attached "DIS/TSS-15 enclosure for guidance on labeling requirements item #6.
 - e. Delete the words "Powerful" and "Quickly".
 - f. Include the heading "Precautionary Statements" before the statement "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".
 - g. Revise "EPA Reg. No. 1270-192-AA" to "EPA Registration No. 1270-192".
 - h. Revise "American Made Proudly by" to "Manufactured By"

i. Delete the statement "Clean Across American and throughout the World".

2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, agrees with the label claim (the nominal concentration) and is acceptable.

3. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(a). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

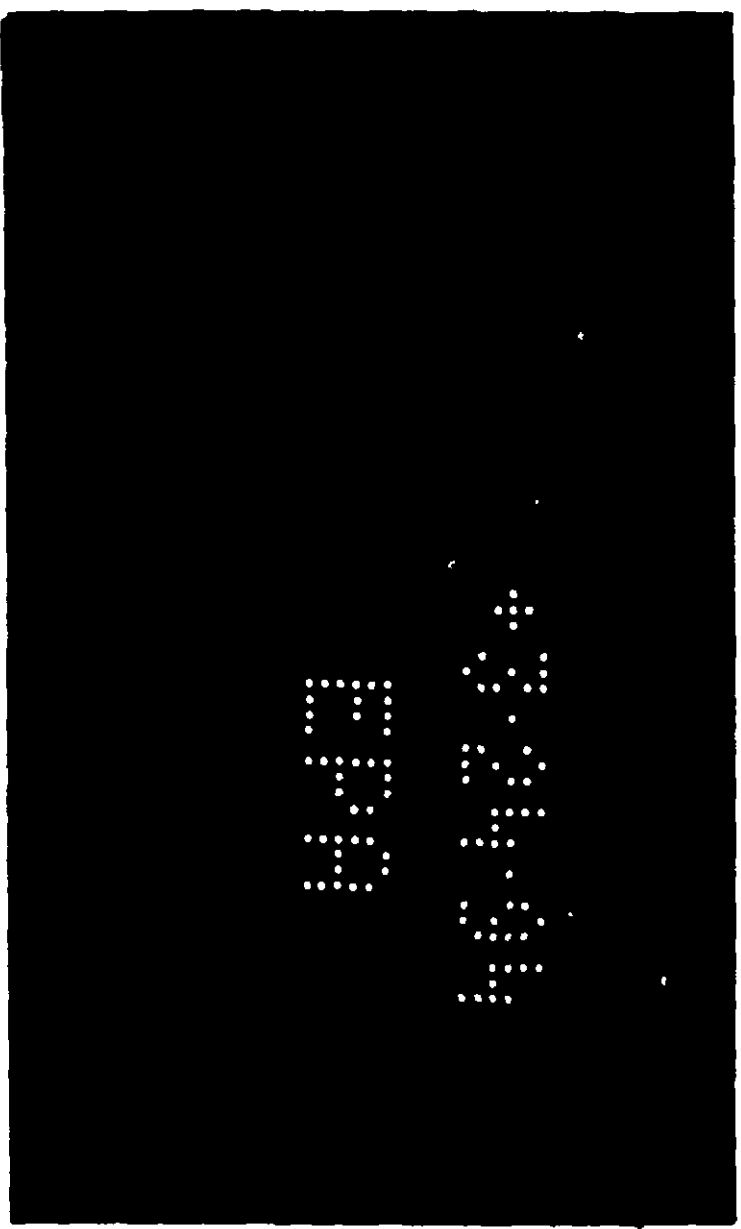
