DILLS: Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Cockroaches, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and exposed stages of Saw-toothed Grain Beetles (Indoors), Hornets, Wasps, Fleas, Flies, and Mosquitoes (Outdoors only).

DIRECTIONS

GENERAL: MIX 1 PART PRODUCT WITH 9 PARTS WATER FOR ALL APPLICATIONS. Apply diluted product with a low-pressure sprayer equipped with a coarse spray nozzle. Spray surfaces only until wet. Avoid excessive runoff. Apply to all insect breeding sites and harborages. Also treat adjacent exposed surfaces where insects may crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat treatment as necessary.

COCKROACHES: Thoroughly treat the infested area with properly diluted product. Spray baseboards, cracks and crevices, around window and door frames, under surfaces of shelves, drawers and work tables, behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and stoves, in and around waste containers, switch panels, junction boxes, floor drains, and other places where cockroaches hide or nest.

ANTS: Apply diluted product to trails and places where ants enter premises such as around window frames and door sills. Spray hills and runways outdoors.

EXPOSED SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Thoroughly spray diluted product on floors and walls of infested areas with attention to cracks, crevices, corners, and perimeters. Sanitation and dust control are of primary importance. Fumigate or destroy infested products.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray diluted product to sleeping quarter of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SCORPIONS, AND SPIDERS: Thoroughly spray diluted product to the interior and exterior perimeter of the infested premises.

For Clover Mites, pay special attention outside around window frames. **FLEAS, FLIES, MOSQUITOES, HORNETS, AND WASPS (Outdoors Only):** Spray diluted product to infested areas thoroughly outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, and other areas where insects may enter. For Hornets and Wasps, apply after dark when all insects have returned to the nest.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not use as a space spray. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly cleaned. Do not apply to any fabrics, carpets, or other surfaces covered by this product. Test product thoroughly in small, inconspicuous areas before use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or food preparation areas. Do not use in serving areas while food is prepared or processed. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or processed.

WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not get in eyes. If exposure, wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing, and wash with soap and warm water. Do not store near food or food preparation areas. Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly after use. Do not smoke. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water. Seek medical aid. To Physician — Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

This product is toxic to birds and other wildlife. Keep out of areas where birds are likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift or by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only to surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT store near heat or open flame. DO NOT contaminate water. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide is prohibited by Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use of the label, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Regional Office for guidance. Triple rinse (or equivalent) containers before reuse. Do not puncture or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other means.
