SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

For use in Apartments, Condominiums, Nonfood Areas of Kennels and Commercial Theaters, Office Buildings, Schools, Motor Processing Facilities.

General: Use product as a spot treatment for bugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas, and other insects as a coarse spray to localized areas where infestation may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Spiders, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Flies and Mosquitoes: Spray areas where these pests are found, including cracks and crevices, door and window frames; behind and under cabinets and around garbage cans, etc. Pests driven out of hiding places should be applied to ant trails, also around doors and other pest find entrances. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Treat infested areas such as pet beds and near crevices, along and behind baseboard, localized areas of floor and floor coverings present. Old bedding should be removed after treatment of pet areas. DO NOT treat pets with a product registered for flea infestation.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors to repel annoyance from these insects. Spray outdoors in door frames, as well as, other areas where these insects enter. In corners and localized resting areas such as in garages where these insects may be coming to rest on treated surfaces will be necessary.
