Zeposector A Spray Insecticide  
EPA Registration No. 1270-222  
Your Submission dated October 22, 1996

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. The updated CSF dated 10/22/96 for the basic formulation is acceptable and the information has been inserted in the file for the subject product.

1. "RECOMMENDED FOR Use BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS AND/OR COMMERCIAL APPLICATORS".

Place the above statement prominently on the Front Panel under the product name.

2. Under Precautionary Statements, add "feed" wherever "food" is mentioned, i.e.,

- a. ....food/feed handling.....
- .....food /feed processing.....etc.

b. Incorporate the following text:

.....Facilities and equipment in federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an effective cleaning compound, followed by a potable water rinse.

3. Under First Aid, revise the inhalation statement to read:

.....If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

4. Remove the "Storage and Disposal" and "Environmental Hazards" statements from under the "Directions for Use" heading and place them separately.

5. Under "Directions for Use"

a. Incorporate all the instructions for use, such as: "Space Spray", "Contact or Surface Spray" etc. under the heading "Directions for Use".

b. Add the following Note:  
.....When used in hospitals and nursing homes, patients should be removed before treatment. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. DO NOT apply directly to food. DO NOT contaminate food or feedstuffs with this spray. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. DO NOT apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled, with potable water. Ventilate treated area for at least 2 hours prior to returning.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat and open flame. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: DO NOT contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) the container. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths and gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply with mechanical or compressed air sprayer, or with fogger which gives small particle size. Direct spray upwards toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Apply at the rate of 0.6 to 1.0 fluid ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space to be treated. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Repeat as necessary for insect control. CONTACT OR SURFACE SPRAY: To kill roaches, waterbugs, crickets and ants: Cover or remove food before application as described under space spray. Apply with a sprayer that gives large wetting droplets. Force spray into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, areas at base of machinery, behind cabinets, around pipes and openings, along baseboards and other insect harborages. Use 1 gallon of spray per 1000 square feet of surface to be treated. For ants, spray trails and all points of entry into the building. Spray ant nests directly with a soiling application. In all cases, contact as many insects as possible directly with the spray. Repeat applications as necessary for control.
