**WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS, BEES:** Aim spray at nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices to saturate in and around nest openings. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**EARWIGS, SOLEBUGS, CRICKETS, BEETLES, SILVERFISH, CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES:** Apply as a contact spray.

**TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS:** Application should be made when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed. For best results apply in the late afternoon or evening, when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.
