The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you do the following:

1. The submitted Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) indicates that this is an alternate formulation. This is not possible since this is the sole formulation for the product. Submit a CSF which indicates that the replacement formulation containing [REDACTED] instead of [REDACTED] is the basic formulation.
2. Add the following to the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT portion of the label:

Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillate.
Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CRICKETS, BEETLES, SILVERFISH, CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES: Apply as a contact spray.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS: Application should be made when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed. For best results apply in the later afternoon or evening, when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.
