**Conditions**

Revise label as follows:

1. Qualify porcelain surfaces as *glazed* porcelain surfaces.
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows: *Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Maybe harmful if absorbed through skin or swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or in clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.*
3. Reorder your First Aid Statements as follows: *IF IN EYES, IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, IF SWALLOWED* followed by *IF INHALED*.

Allow it to stand for several minutes before scrubbing, then flush and rinse. To disinfect, allow solution to remain in urinal at least 10 minutes after scrubbing.
