NOTE: This notice is required for all pesticides registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) which are subject to the registration requirements of the Act.

- d. Revise the statement beginning "Do not use in commercial food processing . . ." as follows:

Do not use in commercial food/feed processing establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

- e. Add the following paragraph under the Directions for Use:

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

3. On the Confidential Statement of Formula, you must provide the flashpoint of the product with the propellant. The flashpoint reported exceeds the one expected for this product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR 162(h)(2)(iii). (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.) Also, you must provide the upper and lower certified limits based on the pure active ingredients rather than the technical or concentrate. Note that the lower limit of the active must be the same as the label claim in pure active form.

4. For data matrix requirements, you must submit a flammability statement (flashpoint/flame extension).

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
