This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in ULV sprayers which are capable of covering delicate furnishings when using this undiluted product. For use in ULV MECHANICAL AEROSOL GENERATOR: 0.5 fl. ozs. (14.8 ml) of concentrate per 1,000 cu. ft. (28.3 cu. m) of space. Direct aerosol generator upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Close doors and windows for one - two hours after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-occupancy. **SPACE SPRAY:** To kill adult and accessible stages of insect pests: beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, cigarette beetles, Angoumois grain moth, Indian meal moths, grain mites, carpet beetles and spider mites. Direct spray under pallets, hitting as many insects as possible, and then treat upper corners of room and ceiling. **TO KILL HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND SMALL INSECTS:** Direct space spray, directing output towards upper corners of room and ceiling.
