Subject: Label Revision-Addition of Precautionary Statements
Zep Meter Mist Insect Killer
EPA Registration Number 1270-247
Submission dated February 7, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The technical source of these actives lists the ingredient percentages of 9.0%, 18.0%, and 30.0%, respectively, for the compounds pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, and N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide. The Confidential Statement of Formula dated June 18, 1991, is correct, declaring 1.05%, 2.10%, and 3.5%, respectively for pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, and MGK 264. However, the label claims of 1.00%, 2.00%, and 3.24%, respectively, fall below the lower certified limit as declared in column 13b of the CSF. The lower certified limits should be expanded to compensate for this discrepancy which results from the slight overformulation of this product.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC
ANIMALS**

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ZEP METER MIST INSECT KILLER is an insecticide formulation specially designed for use with meter mist dispensing units in non-residential establishments, commercial or institutional areas and pantries of restaurants, food warehouses, bottling plants, hotels, stores, dairies, stables, nursing homes, and other areas where flies, mosquitoes, small flying insects, etc., cause annoyance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Install: Install Meter Mist units at a distance of 12 inches from the floor and where air currents will not blow directly into the room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of room (30 x 20 x 10) for 30 days, 24 hours.

To Operate: Remove protective cap and turn on dispenser. If the unit has an automatic timer, set for an interval of 15 minutes. The amount of insecticide dispensed every cycle will be noticeable in one hour. As with all insecticides, for best control, best results are achieved when used in conjunction with positive insect prevention protection.
