The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The technical source of these actives lists the ingredient percentages of 9.0%, 18.0%, and 30.0%, respectively, for the compounds pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, and bicycloheptene dicarboximide. The Confidential Statement of Formula dated June 18, 1991, is correct, declaring 1.05%, 2.10%, and 3.5%, respectively for pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, and MGK However, the label claims of 1.00%, 2.00%, and 3.24%, 264. respectively, fall below the lower certified limit as declared in column 13b of the CSF. The lower certified limits should be expanded to compensate for this descrepency which results from the slight overformulation of this product.
