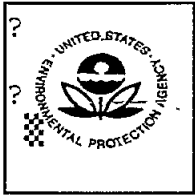

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label change:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 127-253".
 - b. Change the statement "Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants" to "Not for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants".
 - c. Since the product is designed for industrial/institutional use add the following statement to front panel:

"For Industrial/Institutional Use Only".

- d. The label must state the site(s) of application, i.e.

"For Use In and Around: Industrial buildings, schools, hospitals, non-food/feed areas of storage warehouses, vessels, railcars, trucks, trailers, food handling establishments, etc."

- 2. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
- 3. Submit a copy of your Offer To Pay Statement.

Your August 7, 1996, letter states that your product is substantially similar to reg. no. 4816-639, implying that you wished to use data from that product to support your data requirements. However, the two products are not substantially similar and do not share all of the same active ingredients; thus, reg. no. 4816-639 cannot be used to support your product. Nonetheless, your August 6, 1996, registration application states that your product is substantially similar to reg. no. 4816-774. As reg. no. 4816-774 was found to be substantially similar to your product, it may be used as a data reference for your product.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

INDOORS:

CLUSTER FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, BLACK FLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOW FLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS IN BUILDINGS - SPACE SPRAY: Hold can 36 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor, sofa and chair surfaces are contacted. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment after 7 days or as needed.

FLEAS & TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture and mattresses may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets, Wasps and Yellow Jackets: Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.
