
DIRECTIONS

To clean and sanitize floors, walls, tables, food utensils, bathroom fixtures and garbage cans; mop or wash with solution containing 2 ounces sanitizing cleaner per gallon of water. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality.
