**FOR CLEANING SOFT SERVE MACHINES**

Empty freezer and mixer. Fill mix hopper with cold water and rinse through freezer. Add 1 1/2 ounces Sanitizer Cleaner to 3 gallons of hot water and fill unit of powder is dissolved. Pour this solution into mix hopper and operate about 5 minutes, then drain.

**TO SANITIZE SOFT SERVE MACHINES & EQUIPMENT**

Rinse after cleaning as above. Then sanitize with a fresh solution of 100 ppm of available chlorine (1/2 ounce to each gallon of water). After making sanitizing solution according to above instructions, test the solution for ppm of chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store in a cool dry area away from direct sunlight and heat. In case of spill flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard by placing in trash collection or by burying it in approved land fill area. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
