

USE DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1½ ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas - mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 3 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water.

Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

USE DIRECTIONS

FOR DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants and rest rooms mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1½ ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 2 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water and then disinfected. All treated food contact surfaces and or equipment must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents, and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, wall-ways and other areas, mop area with a solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 2 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water before disinfection.

SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 1½ ounces of PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT at a rate of 2-3 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing 1½ ounces of PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. All treated food contact and or equipment must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 1½ ounces of PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. When used as directed PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT will disinfect hard surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails and other areas where obnoxious areas may develop. This product may be used as a disinfectant in homes, schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes and rest rooms.

DANGER
