SG 703 IS USED TO CONTROL POOLS. For maximum effectiveness, algae should be cleaned prior to treatment. For pools having just visible algae, use 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of SG 703 per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools with heavy debris, clean the pool first.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned pool, use 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of SG 703 per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of algae, treat with 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of SG 703 per 10,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

SG 703 is compatible with other pool chemicals and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. It is not treated with chlorine chemicals normally required. Handle dry or liquid chlorine products with care.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container tightly closed. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Recycle or dispose of container properly. The container must be triple-rinsed before recycling, reconditioning, or disposal. Rinseate that cannot be recycled should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Open dumping is prohibited.
