4. If the pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above is not recycled or not filtered, it should be tested periodically to determine the active ingredient content. When necessary, one gallon of Marnolia Algicide and Surface Disinfectant for Swimming Pools per 50,000 gallons of water should be added to maintain five parts per million of active ingredient.

2. Apply to the curative agent of athlete's foot by applying pathways, poolside and locker room floors with solution of Marnolia Algicide and Surface Disinfectant for Swimming Pools. It is also to disinfect bathing suits and caps.

1. Clean floors and runners with suitable detergent, rinse, then mop with solution containing one ounce Marnolia Algicide and Surface Disinfectant for Swimming Pools per gallon of water.

2. After washing, immerse suits and caps for ten minutes in solution containing one ounce Marnolia Algicide and Surface Disinfectant for Swimming Pools per gallon of water. Rinse, wring and hang to dry.
