Udder-Du is an iodine sanitizer and udder wash for use on dairy cows.

Udder-Du may be used in warm, cold, hard or soft water. In use dilution it is not corrosive.

Udder-Du bacterial activity is retained as long as its yellow-brown color is present.

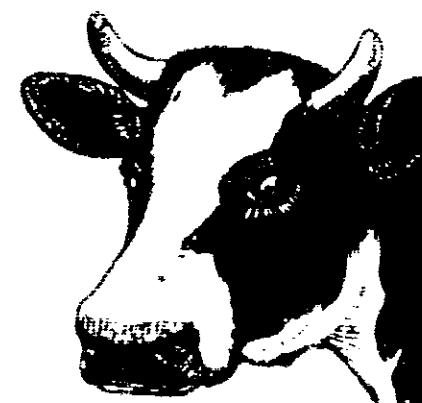

DIRECTIONS

Udder-Du will provide about 2 P.P.M. titratable iodine when diluted with luke warm water as follows:

- 1 Teaspoon Udder-Du to 1 Gallon water.
- 1 Ounce Udder-Du to 10 Quarts water.
- 1 Ounce Udder-Du to 5 Gallons water.

For Udder washing dip clean paper towel in above solution and wash udder, using a fresh towel for each cow. Wipe the teats and udder thoroughly before milking.

Dip previously cleaned teat caps and liners in the above solution before placing on cows.
