

POOL CARE DIRECTIONS

1. To establish a chlorine residual in newly-filled pools, add 2 ounces (two heaping table-spoonfuls) for each 10,000 gallons of water. Repeat dosage until a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm is obtained as determined by use of a chlorine test kit.
2. Thereafter repeat the above dosage daily or as needed to maintain 1.0 to 1.5 ppm chlorine residual at all times. Test pool frequently with a chlorine test kit.
3. Maintain the pH of the pool water between 7.2 and 7.6. Use muriatic acid to lower pH and soda ash to raise pH. Use test kit to determine pH.

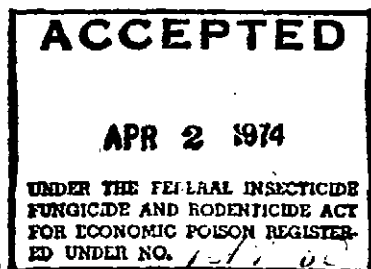
