The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated October 29, 1996) has been added to the product file and supersedes all previously-submitted confidential statements of formula for the basic formulation.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comment:

1. Revise the sentence "Do not contaminate milk or milk handling equipment" to read "Do not contaminate milk, milk handling equipment, feed, or drinking water."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed. Submit three copies of revised final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner
inconsistent with labeling and directions.

SPACE SPRAY: Mix well in drum before use. To attain quick knockdown and kill flies, gnats and mosquitoes in enclosed spaces, spray toward the ceiling and corners until the space is filled with a light mist. For best results, close all windows and doors prior to spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Not to be used on animals to be used for food or feed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not contaminate feeds, water or mineral supplements with this spray. Do not contaminate milk or milk handling equipment with spray. Remove livestock, pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Combustible. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame. Keep container tightly closed.
