The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Delete "pyrethrin" under the first aid statement. This product contains four active ingredients, only one of which is pyrethrin.

Because this product contains petroleum distillate, the "If Swallowed" first aid statement must be revised as follows:

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Below the heading "Storage and Disposal" add the following:
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Add a Pesticide Disposal Statement as follows:

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Revise the Disposal Statement to read as follows:

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or

reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Move the directions for use so that they immediately precede the storage and disposal section.

Revise the first sentence under the Directions for Use as follows:


It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Note that the submitted label specifies the net contents as 5 gallons, but the application specifies the net contents as: 1, 5, 30 and 55 gal. You must clarify the net contents.

The new primary brand name, Fly Foil Spray, referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, and has been recorded in the file jacket for this registration as a replacement for the old primary brand name "Dairy-Du."

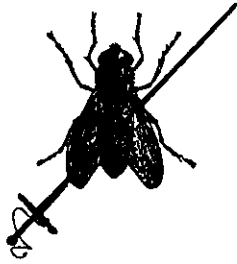

Kills and Repels Horn Flies, Stable Flies,
Horse Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats.

When applied properly, the repellent effect of this spray will last two days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

SPACE SPRAY: Mix well in drum before use. To attain quick knockdown and kill of flies, gnats and mosquitoes in enclosed spaces, spray toward the ceiling and corners until the space is filled with a light mist. For best results, close all windows and doors prior to spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed and before returning animals to the treated area. Not to be used on animals to be used for food or feed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OR REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not contaminate feeds, water or mineral supplements with this spray. Do not contaminate milk, milk handling equipment, feed, or drinking water. Remove livestock, pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID Pyrethrin	
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
