CREAMERIES FOOD PLANTS WINERIES

DIRECTIONS FOR FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS

Close up infested areas (where possible) and spray towards ceiling, filling space with mist. Leave closed 10 or 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas; ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

FOR ANTS, ROACHES: Spray to a moist state around baseboards and other places of their habitation, hitting as many insects as possible.

FOOD PLANTS: To eliminate the possible contamination of processed food, spraying should be done while plant is not in operation. Remove or cover food during treatment. Cover processing surfaces during treatment and wash these surfaces before food is again processed.

Repeat as necessary.

Avoid contamination of foodstuffs.

Do not spray near or towards an open flame.

**CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED**

Do not re-use empty container. Destroy by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.
