DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTANT WITH ITS LABELING.

IODU #2 is double the IODINE content of IODU, providing 3.6% Titratable Iodine equivalent to 43,000 ppm. (Weight/Volume).

BACK-FLUSH FOR TEAT CUPS ON DAIRY FARMS:

To clean/sanitize milking machine teat cups between cows, rinse with clean water, then inject 1-oz. IODU #2 per 13 gallons of water for at least 1 minute, flush, and drain from the unit. Rinse with potable water. **DO NOT REUSE SOLUTION.**

SOLUTION STRENGTH:

For about 25 ppm Titratable Iodine use 1-oz. IODU #2 to each 13 gallons water.

Sanitizing activity is retained as long as its Yellow-Brown color is present.


