## **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

### **HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

#### **DANGER**

**CORROSIVE:** Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. #### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD**

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. #### **PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD**

**STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT.** Contact with water slowly liberates irritating and hazardous gases. Decomposes at temperatures above 437°F with liberation of harmful gases. When ignited, will burn with the evolution of chlorine and equally toxic gases.

**NEVER add water to product. Always add product to large quantities of water.** Use clean, dry utensils. **DO NOT** add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic material, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible fire and explosion.

**IN CASE OF FIRE OR SMOKE:** Call the fire department. Do not attempt to extinguish the fire without a self contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). Do not let the fire burn. **Flood with copious amounts of water. DO NOT** use ABC or other dry chemical extinguishers since there is the potential for a violent reaction.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DAIRY EQUIPMENT:** The equipment should first be cleaned with a proper detergent, rinsed and then sanitized with a **SANI-DU** solution as follows: 1 oz. (about 1 heaping tablespoonful) of **SANI-DU** to each 10 gallons of water. This provides about 100 ppm available chlorine. Have solution in contact with the work a full 2 minutes. (If a solution of 200 ppm available chlorine is needed, use 1 oz. **SANI-DU** to 5 gallons of water. Then follow with a rinse of potable water).

**RESTAURANTS:** For the sanitization of multi-use eating and drinking utensils and multi-use kitchen utensils. Always clean with a suitable detergent, rinse thoroughly, then immerse for at least one minute in a solution of **SANI-DU**: 1 oz. (about 1 heaping tablespoonful) of **SANI-DU** to each 10 gallons of water. This provides about 100 ppm available chlorine. Avoid towel drying. For counters, tables and other inanimate objects, wash with same strength solution and air-dry if practical.

SANI-DU has been cleared under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act for use on food contact surfaces (178.1010(b)(2)).

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## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water, and discard by placing in trash or burying in an approved landfill. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
