DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING WALLS, FLOORS AND WOODWORK: Use 2 parts MINTIDE to 69 parts water. For best results, add the water to the MINTIDE.

TOILET ROOMS: Use 2 parts MINTIDE to 69 parts water. Wash bathtubs, seats, bowls (exterior surfaces) urinals, sinks, floors and baseboards with this solution at least once a day.

CUSPIDORS: Use 2 parts MINTIDE to 59 parts water and wash out thoroughly. Leave part of the solution in each cuspidor for deodorization.

DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF FLOORS, WALLS, TABLES, AND OTHER SMOOTH SURFACES: Wipe with a solution of 2 parts PINEFIVE in 69 parts water. For best results, add the water to the PINEFIVE.

TOILET ROOMS: Use 2 parts PINEFIVE in 69 parts water. Wash bathtubs, seats, bowls (exterior surfaces), urinals, sinks, floors and baseboards with this solution at least once a day.

CUSPIDORS: Use 2 parts PINEFIVE to 59 parts water and wash out well. Leave part of the fresh solution in each unit for deodorization.

STEAMSHIPS, AIRPLANES, RAILROADS, AND BUSES: With a solution of 2 parts PINEFIVE to 69 parts water, scrub floors, wipe seats, woodwork, baths, toilet seats, when cleaning pantries, passageways, and cabins.

SCHOOLS, FACTORIES, AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS: Use a solution of 2 parts PINEFIVE in 69 parts water for mopping and spraying rooms, halls, stairs, and lockers.
