SO-E-Z *delete safely*

The liquid porcelain and bowl cleaner that  cleans, disinfects and deodorizes toilet bowls, urinals and porcelain fixtures.

DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING CLOSET BOWLS The chief source of objectionable odors in closet bowls is usually the uric acid incrustations which form on the under side and inside surfaces of the flush ring. These incrustations are difficult to remove since they are usually hidden from normal view.

To remove these incrustations, pour about two ounces of this cleaner around the edge of the bowl and allow to remain for several minutes. Then thoroughly brush the surface with a stiff bowl brush up under the flush ring and around the inside surface of the bowl. By placing a small mirror under the flush ring, inspect the affected surfaces, and if all incrustations and discolorations have not been removed, repeat the operation, if necessary, until cleaned. After cleaning, rinse bowl thoroughly by flushing.

After bowl has been thoroughly cleaned it may be kept clean by daily pouring a small amount of this cleaner into the water at the bottom of the bowl and brushing the solution under flush ring and around the inside surface of the bowl.

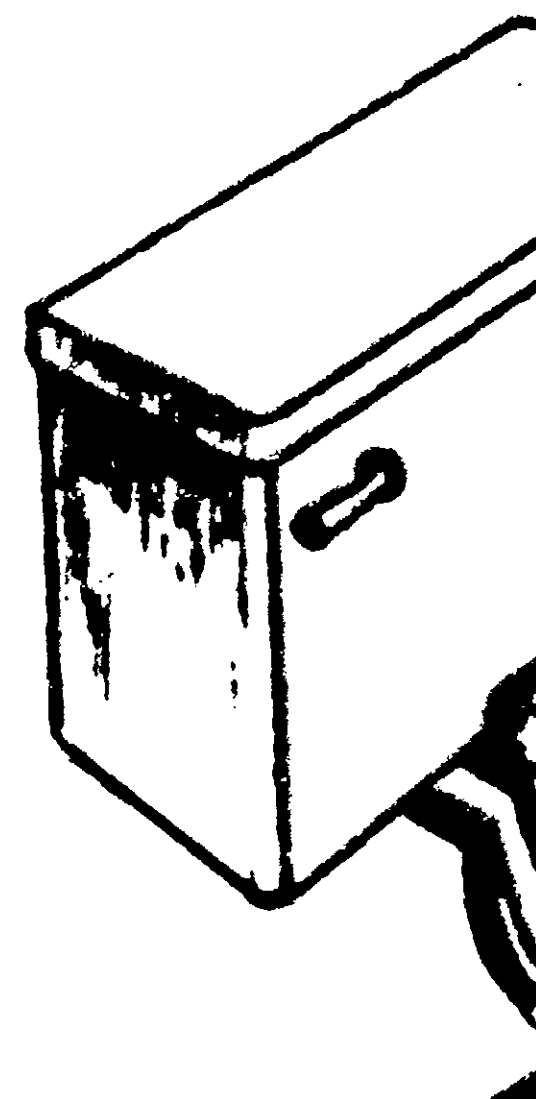
FOR CLEANING URINALS Odors from urinals usually come from the drain pipe in the base of the urinal or from incrustations underneath flush ring or from the floor surface surrounding the urinal.

To thoroughly clean the drain pipe, remove the protecting screen over it and put about eight ounces of this cleaner around the edges of the pipe and allow to remain for a short time. Then remove the accumulated waste matter with a urinal brush and thoroughly rinse by flushing. This material is heavier than water and will collect in the urinal trap until flushed. Allowing it to remain there for a short time removes odorous scales and algae growth.

For cleaning flush ring and floor surrounding urinal, use same procedure as directed in preceding instructions for cleaning closet bowls.

For maintaining a clean urinal, a small amount of this cleaner should be poured into the drain pipe and applied to flush ring at regular intervals. Always follow by rinsing.

CAUTION The use of this cleaner on other than vitreous ware is done at user's own risk. Never allow this material to contact skin, fabrics, soft flooring, painted or varnished surfaces as it attacks organic matter.

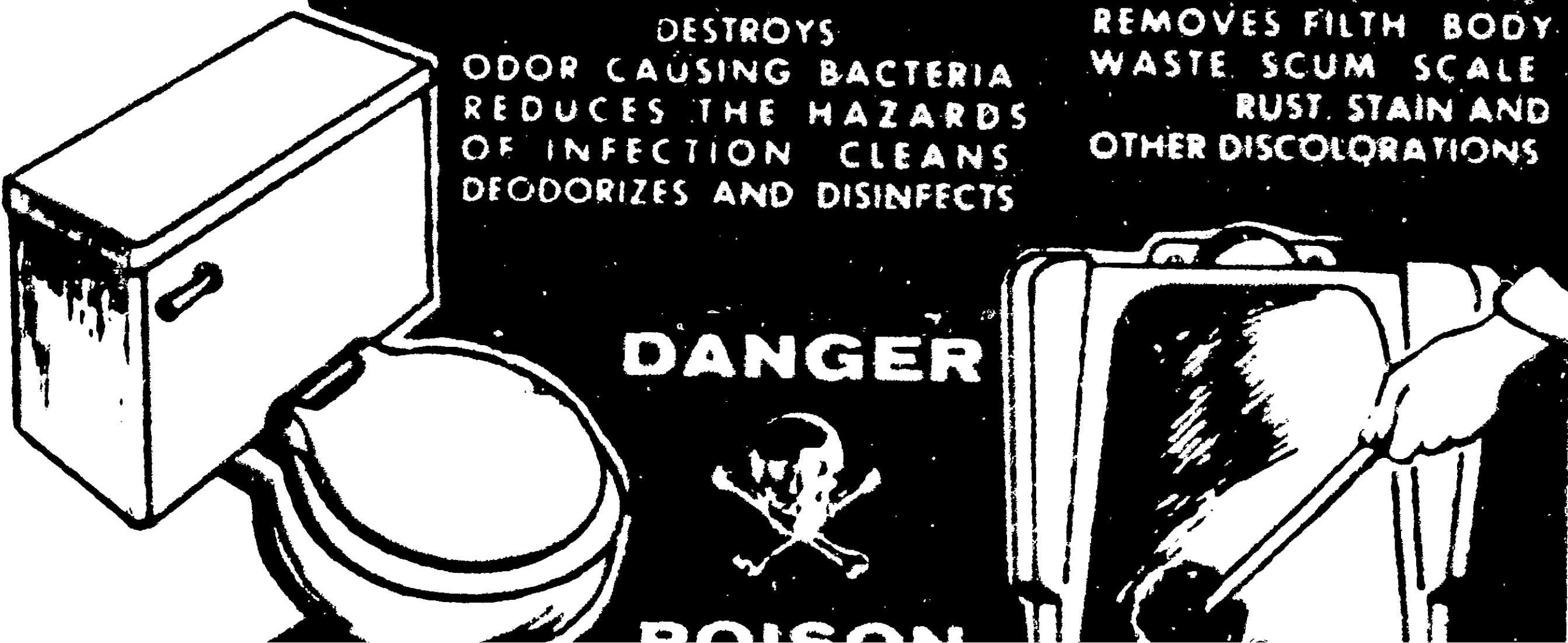
