DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Initial Dose: 1 gallon Betacide to 50,000 gallons of water.
Maintenance Dose: 1 quart Betacide to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial Dose is used when filling pool at beginning of season.

When algae growth is visible, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the killed algae are removed from the pool.

Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of Betacide for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week.

FOR USE AS A POOL-SIDE GERMICIDE

After cleaning surfaces, use 1 oz. Betacide to 4 gallons of water for sanitizing or 1 oz. Betacide to 2 gallons of water for disinfecting. At this dilution Betacide will also deodorize surfaces efficiently.

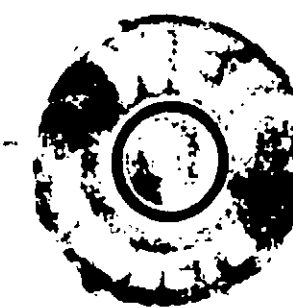

Betacide is used as directed, it will kill and prevent growth of Chlorocella pyrenoidosa (green), Phormidium, and other algae. Phormidium, Lyngbya, and other swimming pool algae.

Betacide is non-toxic, non-irritating, and non-corrosive when used as directed. It is recommended.

Betacide is compatible with most common pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. Betacide works best when added by hand directly to pool water.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Avoid contact with food.
