HOSPITALS AND CLINICS

PATHOCIDE FOR CLEANING

As a cleaner Pathocide is unique because of its high detergency, excellent soil suspension and superior wetting quality. Yet with all this cleaning power, Pathocide does not damage any surface where water itself may be used. In use dilutions (1 to 3 oz. per gallon of water) Pathocide is nonirritating, nonsensitizing, noncorrosive, and nontoxic.

PATHOCIDE FOR DEODORIZING

Pathocide eliminates odor without masking as it has no fragrance of its own (unless specifically ordered). Odor elimination is achieved at the very source of the odor, the bacteria which clings to surfaces. This bacteria which emit odor causing gases, are completely destroyed by Pathocide. The use dilution for cleaning is adequate for removal of most odors, but in unusual circumstances where odors persist 3 oz. per gallon of water is recommended.

FOR DISINFECTING ONLY

When an area of surface has already been cleaned, an effective disinfectant dilution of 1 oz. per gallon of water is recommended. For general disinfection 3 oz. per gallon of water is recommended.

FOR CLEANING, DISINFECTING, AND DEODORIZING

On all surfaces where it is used, Pathocide must be used in a dilution of 1 oz. per gallon of water. Under extreme conditions it may be necessary to use up to 3 oz. per gallon of water. In either case, the dilution is active and must be used.

For disinfection of Pathocide, use a dilution of 3 oz. per gallon of water.
