FOR USE IN ELECTRIC OR GAS ENGINE THERMO-FOG MACHINES.

"WS" Fogging Concentrate is a CONTACT insecticide formulated to help control exposed, crawling, or flying, insects in Furniture Storage, and other Warehouse areas. It should always be used in conjunction with "RS" RESIDUAL INSECTISIDE for effective control of insect infestations.

See "RS" label for specific insect control.

Fogged heavily throughout a warehouse it is effective, on contact, against roaches, water-bugs, silverfish, mosquitoes, wasps, weevils, ants, carpet beetles, and certain other insects.

NOT FOR USE IN FOOD PREPARATION AREAS OR FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BEFORE FOGGING

All open flames or pilot lights must be extinguished before fogging operation begins. Prior to fogging with WS treat the warehouse every three to four weeks with RS residual insecticide according to the directions on the label. Pay particular attention to all cracks in floors and walls. Clean up accumulations of dust and cob-webs. Eliminate all drafts possible.

WHEN TO FOG

Since CONTACT insecticides are effective only while they are in the air, it is necessary to fog once a week in cold weather; two or three times a week in mild weather; and once a day when 70° or warmer weather.

HOW TO FOG

If there is a draft in the building, begin fogging on the down-wind side. Move across the building and toward the wind. Always move away from the fog. If possible eliminate all drafts. Fog heavily forcing the fog to the ceiling.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

Building must be vacated before fogging operation begins. Ventilate well before reentry. Avoid breathing of spray or fog. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands and face with soap and water after fogging. Do not use on or around household pets or animals. Do not spray or fog near open flame. Although this insecticide has a high flash point, it will burn when sprayed or fogged. Do not smoke while fogging. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned after treatment. If prolonged fogging is required use a respirator.
