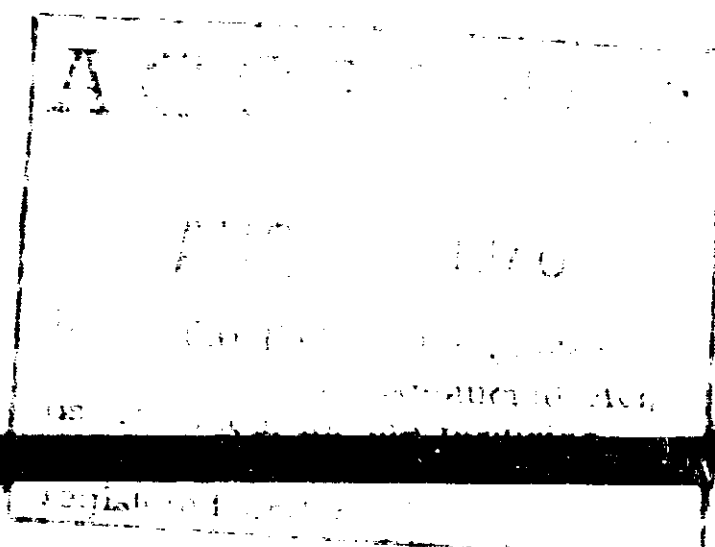




Concentrated detergent, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide and deodorizer. It is specifically designed for institutional use, such as, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and Schools, where housekeeping will be of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross-infection from environmental surfaces.

For use on floors, walls and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, hotels, Public Areas, Industrial Areas and in institutions. It is excellent for Operating Rooms, Rest Rooms, Nurseries and Food Services Areas.

When used as directed it is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. Also effective against pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton interdigitale*.

USE DIRECTIONS

Disinfection

Use at 1 ounce per gallon of water. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* FRO-10 at this level.

At 1 ounce per gallon of water, this product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results use as directed above with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

NET CONTENTS ON CONTAINER

Sanitization

If used for sanitization of previous or food contact items, limit the level 200 ppm (1.4 ounces per 5 gallons) this level with Potable Water.

This product when used on environmental surfaces at 1 ounce per gallon of Influenza A2, Herpes Simplex, Adenoviruses.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water before returning drum to drum reconditioner.

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin irritation. In eyes, on skin or on clothing. H. contamination of food. Protect eye concentrate.

FIRST AID

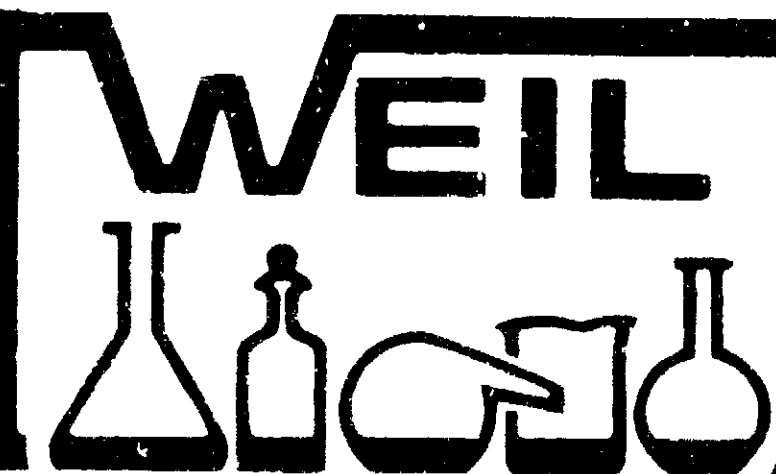

NET CONTENTS ON CONTAINER

Sanitization

If used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items, limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (1.4 ounces per 5 gallons of water). Rinse required at this level with Potable Water.

This product when used on environmental inanimate, hard surfaces at 1 ounce per gallon of water, is effective against Influenza A2, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 1, and Vaccinia viruses.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water before discarding or returning drum to drum conditioner.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Stomach mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
