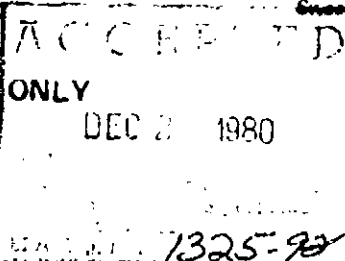

CONTACT SPRAY: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain moths, sawtooths, spiders and centipedes. Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other harborage. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors, around window frames, ant trails and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: (Adults of Confused Flour Beetle, Sawtoothed Grain Beetle, Shiny Spider Beetle). Remove infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and feedstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In homes, dispose of all infested products. The shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed so as to contact all pests, and covered with shell paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any utensils that are contacted with spray should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.

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
