

DIRECTIONS

ADDITIONAL WARNING

FIRST AID

EXTERNAL — In case of spillage on skin, wash promptly with soap and water.

INTERNAL — Emetic of 1 tablespoonful of mustard in tumbler of water. Call a physician.

SYMPTOMS

Recognizable symptoms of acute intoxication are hyperexcitability, tremors, convulsions and eventually paralysis. Symptoms of chronic intoxication are usually not as clearly defined as those of acute, but in general are similar and slowly progressive. In addition a history of the loss of appetite, loss of weight and headaches may be present.

NOTE TO ATTENDING PHYSICIAN: Treatment for Chlordane is primary symptomatic. The following have been suggested:

- 1- An attempt should be made to control nervous symptoms and convulsions by use of sedatives and anticonvulsants. Suggested materials are: phenobarbital, sodium pentobarbital and chloralhydrate. Use at levels that maintain freedom from symptoms but which do not interfere with eating or excretion.
- 2- Definite measures should be taken to encourage appetite. Parenteral feeding if patient is comatose.
- 3- In cases of intoxication by ingestion, oily laxatives and enemas should be avoided.
- 4- Provide a quiet place as free from noises or other source of irritation as possible.
- 5- Supportive treatment consistent with that used in liver or central nervous system impairment.
