

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not fail to use this product in a manner recommended.

RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Treated areas for 48 hours unless otherwise specified.

This product is such a manner as to directly or through contact other persons. The area being treated must be entered by persons.

Treated areas without protective clothing and sprays, have

BARLEY, OATS, RYE AND WHEAT — For control of barley thrips, use 1 to 1 pint per acre. For aphids (including greenbug, a. amygdalius, leafhopper, and winter grain aphids) use 1 to 1½ pints per acre. For climbing cutworms and grasshoppers use ½ to 1 pint per acre. For chinch bugs, false chinch bugs and Say's plant bugs, use 1½ pints per acre. For western or broad wheat mites, and grasshoppers use 1 pint per acre. Do not use more than ½ pint per acre within 1½ days of harvest.

COTTON — For control of armyworms, climbing cutworms, cotton bollworm, tobacco budworm, fall armyworm, tobacco bugs, use ½ pint per acre. For grasshoppers, 1½ pint per acre. Do not apply within 12 days of harvest or cotton bollworm.

FRUIT, PLUMS AND PEACHES — For control of codling moth, European corn borer, apple aphid, rosy apple aphid, green peach aphid, many plum aphid, plum curculio, plum psyllid, Oriental fruit moth, codling moth and wasp, use ½ pint to 1 quart per 100 gallons of water. Spray tree trunks at time of moth flight to control pests like codling, plum curculio and Oriental fruit moth; spray at petal fall, black cherry split and 3 to 4 applications, 8 to 14 days thereafter, to maintain control. Do not use more than 1 gallon of this product per acre.

PINEAPPLE — For control of aphids, armyworms, fir beetles, Mediterranean, Lygus bugs, 2 Sutton, use 1 to 2 pints per acre. For coconuts, mainly mealy, surface feeding and climbing cutworms and pink bollworm, use 2 pints per acre. Raised planting pine should not be applied closer than 15 days after transplanting.

VEGETABLES — For control of climbing cutworms and fall armyworm, tobacco hornworm, use ½ pint per acre. For fall armyworm, tobacco hornworm, use ½ to 1 pint per acre. For beet armyworm, Mexican bean beetle, bean aphid, bean leaf beetle, bean aphid, velvet bean aphid, use 1 pint per acre. For bollworms, fall armyworm, and various caterpillars, use 1 quart per acre. Do not apply within 10 days before harvest or

within 10 days after harvest, use ½ to 1 pint per acre. Do not apply within 8 days after propagation. For control of beetles, ants and crayfish may be applied where these are important resources.

COTTON — For control of thrips, use ½ to 1½ pint per acre. For cotton leafhopper, use ½ to 1½ pint per acre. For grasshoppers and fall armyworms, use ½ pint per acre. For spider mites (does not control all species), use ½ to 1½ pint per acre. For control of fleahoppers, Lygus and other stink bugs, use ½ quart to 1 quart per acre. For boll weevils, aphids and garden webworms, use ½ to 1 pint per acre. For false chinch bugs use 1½ pint per acre. For cutworms, use 1 to 2 pints per acre. For bollworms, salt-marsh caterpillars, armyworms, cotton leaf perforators and stink bugs, use 1 quart per acre. Applications should be made at 4 to 6 day intervals until control is obtained. At above dosages, application may be made up to the day before harvest, if harvest will be with mechanical pickers.

CAUTION — When necessary to enter treated cotton fields within 3-4 hours after application, protective clothing should be worn. Do not apply earlier 7 days of handpicking cotton.

GRASS (FORAGE) — For rangeland caterpillars, use 1 pint per acre. For control of armyworms, grasshoppers, bugs, false chinch bugs, grasshoppers and leafhoppers, use 1½ pints per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest or grazing.
