
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control flies, mosquitoes, cock
 craches, ants, spiders, silverfish, wasps,
 gnats, flying moths, and other small fly-
 ing insects in houses, restaurants,
 theaters, food processing plants, and
 other parts of warehouses, apply a
 solution (see mixing table) as a
 spray, with special attention to standard
 P.M.O. practices.

Apply with low pressure sprayer to
 infested areas. Insects may retreat. Treat
 infested areas over and over. Insects
 tracks, walls, and window frames,
 and crevices are good targets. Do not
 apply to areas which will be used for
 the purpose of food and drink. Do not
 blow them on treated areas until surfaces
 are dry. Do not contaminate food, water,
 food containers, or kitchen utensils.
 Do not treat animals.
