GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Prepare a spray mixture of Cotton States No. 42 Tox-MP as follows:

- 1. Add about half the total amount of water to be used to the spray tank.
- 2. Start agitator or pump bypass and add proper amount of Cotton States No. 42 Tox-MP.
- 3. Continue mixing and add remaining water.

Directions for Use on COTTON

Cotton States No. 42-Tox-MP may be applied by either ground equipment or aircraft. For ground equipment, dilute in sufficient water to give adequate coverage. For aerial applications, dilute in 3 to 4 gallons of water per acre.

Early Season Program: For general early season control of plant bugs and fleahoppers, use 1 to 1.25 pints Cotton States No. 42 for MP per acre. Make two or three applications at 7 day intervals starting at the two-leaf stage. For thrip control, use .75 to 1 pint per acre and for cutworms use 1.5 to 2 pints per acre.

Mid Season Insects: Overwintering to III weevils, plant bugs, aphids, and cotton lead worms are controlled with 1.5 to 2 pints Cotton States No. 42 Tox-MP per acre. Make repeat treatment at 7 day intervals as insect counts indicate they are necessary.

Late Season Control: Use 4 pints per acre to control boll weevils bollworms and aphids. Repeat applications at 5 to 7 day intervals as insects counts indicate they are necessary.
