DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CUT SEED: Seed-borne Common Scab, Fusarium Seed Piece Decay- Apply Dithane Seed Treating Dust at the rate of 1 pound for each 100 lbs of cut seed. For effective control, the dust should be applied to the entire surface of the seed pieces immediately after cutting.

UNCUT SEED: For uncut seed in the treatment of Seed-borne common scab, the recommended rate of application is $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 pound of Dithane Seed Treating Dust for each 100 lbs of uncut seed. If uncut seed that has been treated is cut at a later date, it should be re-treated as cut seed to avoid disease contamination on the newly exposed surfaces.
