This product is suitable for use in conventional power sprayers or low pressure knapsack sprayers. Just prior to use, mix the required amount of this product in sufficient water and apply in accordance with State and Federal recommendations. Do Not treat caives under 6 mos. of age. Brahma Cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

DIRECTIONS FOR LIVESTOCK PEST CONTROL

For control of Stable Flies. Horn Flies, House Flies, Lice and Lone Star Ticks on Dairy Cattle, Beer Cattle, Sheep Goats and Hogs: Mix 1 quart of this product per 6 gals. of water (1% Concentration). Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs, using 1-2 pts. of spray per large animal and proportionately less for smaller animals.

For pen or corral operations involving spray applications to livestock with high pressure equipment, do not exceed a 0.5% concentration (1 qt. to 12 gallons of water). Spray to thoroughly cover the animal's body and legs (avoid excessive spraying of the head) using 1-2 qts. of spray per large animal and proportionately less for smaller animals. 
