1. Add Flo-Pro Mc Seed Protectant concentrate to cool tap water and mix thoroughly for 15 mins. to prepare the Flo-Pro Mc dilution.
2. Add Flo-Pro Seed Protectant Liquid Dye to the Flo-Pro Mc dilution and mix for an additional 10 minutes.
3. Apply with commercial seed treating equipment such as a slurry treater.
