**DIRECTIONS**

Dilute as directed. Do not mix with other cleaners.

To clean, disinfect and deodorize nonporous surfaces: Use 1/2 oz. per gallon on floors, walls, kitchen and lab equipment, washroom fixtures, showers, lockers, garbage and refuse cans. For porous surfaces (cement block, scarred furniture) or grossly contaminated surfaces, use 1/2 oz. per gallon with special attention to thorough cleaning. Potable water rinse required when disinfecting hard surface food contact items. **Fogging:** To fog unoccupied rooms as an adjunct to regular cleaning-disinfecting routines, use 1 1/2 ozs. per gallon per average room. Allow 2 hours minimum after fogging before entering room. Do not use in presence of humans, animals or plants.

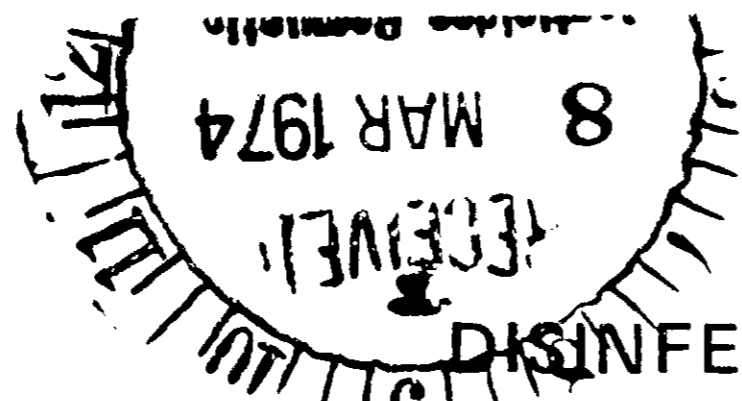
