

...and, kitchen and lab equipment, washroom fixtures, showers, lockers, garbage and refuse cans. For porous surfaces (cement block, scarred furniture) or grossly contaminated surfaces, use 1 oz. per gallon with special attention to thorough cleaning. Do not use for disinfecting hard surface food contact items. **Fogging:** To fog unoccupied rooms as an adjunct before or after regular cleaning-disinfecting routines, use 3 ozs. per gallon of water per average room. Allow 2 hours minimum after fogging before entering room. Do not use in presence of humans, animals or plants.

DANGER! KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol and call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probably mucosal damage may contra-indicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.



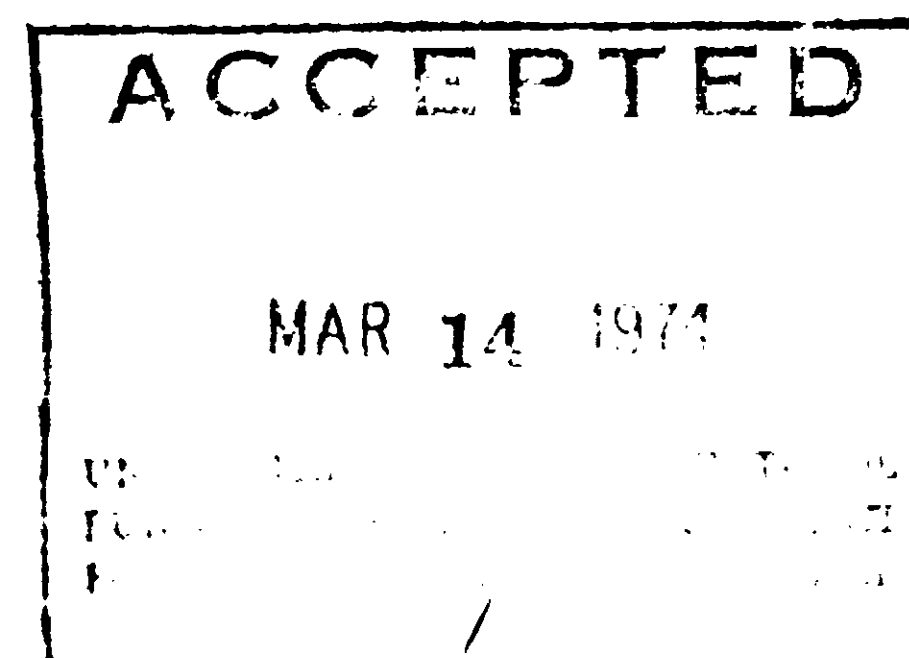
