

DE-O-DIS germicide or disinfectant has a synthetic like odor. It can be used where clean and sanitary quarters are desired. Is very adaptable for use in public and private institutions.

**CAUTION:** For external use only. Harmful if swallowed. If accidentally swallowed give the following antidotes; milk, raw egg, raw-illage and follow with emetic (tablespoonful of mustard in a glass of warm water). Call a physician. Avoid inhalation of fumes of undiluted material as well as contact with skin. In case of contact, wash with large quantity of water.

**DIRECTIONS:** Place the DE-O-Dis in the container for the solution first, then add the water. Mix well.

**FLOORS:** When mopping or scrubbing, use 2 oz. of DE-O-DIS to a gal. of water.

**GENERAL DISINFECTING:** Clean to remove all dirt and filth from the area or premises, then disinfect with a solution of 2 oz. of DE-O-DIS to a gal. of water.
