This DISINFECTANT is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria.

This DISINFECTANT is also an excellent deodorant. It is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin.

This DISINFECTANT mixes readily with water and makes a clear, stable solution. In use dilution it is non-corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals. Has a pleasant mint odor.

USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTANT: of hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, painted porcelain, etc.) in restrooms, either vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces, on walls, floors, appliances and furniture, in public rooms, offices, and industrial areas.

CLEANING AND DEODORIZING: With one gallon of water, mix one quart of water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 5 to 8 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING: Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 5 ounces of THIS DISINFECTANT per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OF GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT. It is especially important to pre-clean, in order for the disinfectant to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

FOR CLEANING OF WALLS, FLOORS AND INDUSTRIAL WORK AREAS: Use 5-8 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for personnel doing continuous hand cleaning.

THIS DISINFECTANT may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

THIS DISINFECTANT is not recommended for hospitals or nursing homes.

This product must not be used on food contact surfaces.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing spray mist.
