

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LIQUID FLY BAIT: To control house and stable flies in Barns, Feed Lots, Poultry Houses, U ity Buildings and around food disposals, mix 5 ounces with 5 runces of corn syrup and add 2

disposals, mix 5 ownces with 5 vances of corn syrup and add 2 gallons of water. Paint or spray desired surfaces such as window fram s, stanchions, support ams and doorways.

SWINE: For lice, mix 1 gallon per 100 gallons of water. Apply a complete spray to animals, pens and litter. One treatment may be sufficient. Repeat applications only if needed.

SEFF CATTLE A NON-LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE: For lice, add 1 gallon 57% Malathion to 100 gallons of water. For lice, mix 1 to 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water. For lies, mix 1 to 1½ gallons per 100 gallons of water. Apply complete coverage spray. Repeat at 2 week intervals if needed. Do not spray cattle during lactation or within two weeks of freshening. Do not apply to calves under one month of age. ing. Do not apply to calves under one month of age.

NOTE: When applying Malathion sprays do not contaminate food containers and watering troughs. Do not contaminate milk, milking equipment, feed or drinking water.

BACK RUBBING DEVICES: As an aid in the control of lice or horn flies on Beef Cattle, apply a mixture of 2% Malathion (1 gallon 57% Malathion to 28½ gallons fuel oil or kerosene, or 1 quart 57% Malathion to 7¼ gallons oil) to the back rubbing device. These devices should be made continuously accessible, one to each 35 to 45 head of cattle. Refrest the oiler every 2 to 3 weeks. De not apply to dairy animals.
