Amendment to revise First Aid Statement.

Dear Dr. Walker:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. You must change the EPA Registration No. to be 1381-171 on the label when printing new labels and when submitting the final printed labeling.
2. Under the statement "If inhaled" delete the first "to" in the statement "preferably to mouth-to-mouth, if possible" so that it reads "preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible".

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

 - Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
 - Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
 - Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
 - Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled**
 - Move person to fresh air.
 - If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably to mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
 - Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Atropine is antidotal for acetylcholine poisoning. Give 2 mg of atropine intramuscularly or subcutaneously and repeat if symptoms of poisoning persist. Pralidoxime (P-25 or P-2AM) may also be given if available. Give one gram intramuscularly or intravenously and repeat as necessary.
