Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate significance of exposure (baseline data are useful). Give 2 mg. of atropine intramuscularly or subcutaneously and repeat if symptoms of poisoning reappear. Pralidoxime (2 PAM) may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In case of severe poisoning, use antidote immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration.

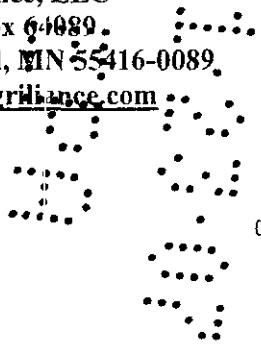
