Winfield Solutions, LLC is submitting an amendment to the subject product by notification as allowed under PR Notice 98-10. In line with a similar amendment by notification made by FMC Corporation for their Brigade 2EC registration, EPA Reg. No., 279-3313, and acknowledged by the Agency on October 28, 2008, we are similarly adding a use dilution minimum of 2 gallons per acre when applied by air (to the 10 gallons ground application dilution already on the label). This is being added under the notification provisions of PR Notice 98-10, Part II M Directions for Use, 1. Changes in mixing directions which do not affect the dilution ratio or the minimum or maximum use dilutions. The OPPTS Part 860.1500 guidelines, paragraph (e)(2)(xi)(A) allow that residues from ground applications at 10 gallon dilutions are equivalent to residues from 2 gallon aerial use dilutions.

To process this notification, enclosed are:

- ▶ An application for Pesticide Notification (EPA Form 8570-1)
- ▶ Certification with Respect to Label Integrity form
- ▶ 2 copies of labeling, in supplemental labeling form, covering the application of Tundra EC to soybeans. The changes are highlighted on one copy.

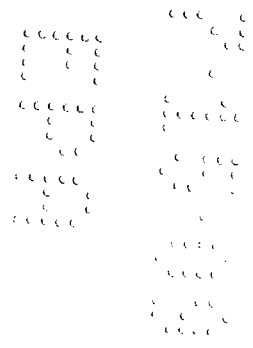
