Dear Ms. Ramswick:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes given below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. The Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section should read:

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

2. The Statement of Practical Treatment/If Swallowed should read:

Do not induce vomiting because of the danger of aspiration pneumonia. Get medical attention immediately.

3. The Statement of Practical Treatment/If In Eyes should read:

Flush eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical treatment.

4. Add an Environmental Hazards statement:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

We have begun the processing of your request to cancel the registration of Spray Oil, EPA Registration Number 1386-246. The request for voluntary cancellation will be handled as a separate action.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Do not apply when wind is blowing. Do not use where runoff may occur as a result of heavy rain. **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:**  
If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately.  
If On Skin: Wash area with soap and water. If irritation develops, consult a physician.  
If In Eyes: Flush eyes with large quantities of potable water for at least 15 minutes.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD

Do not store, use, or spill near heat or open flame. Do not weld, heat, or drill container. Residue may ignite with explosive violence.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the directions on the label. **DO NOT APPLY THIS PRODUCT THROUGH ANY TYPE OF IRRIGATION SYSTEM.**  
**DECIDUOUS FRUIT TREES**—During the dormant or delayed-dormant period, use 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water and apply spray thoroughly to trunks, branches, and young leaves on bright clear days when the temperature is above 45° F., during the time that young leaves are not more than 1/2 inch in length.

During the summer when foliage is present, use 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water and apply spray thoroughly to foliage and branches to control scale insects, two-spotted mite, red bug, and pear, preferably before they cause noticeable damage, and repeat at 30-day intervals until 3 applications have been made during the growing season.

**ORNAMENTAL SHADE TREES AND HARDY SHRUBS**—During the dormant period, use 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water and apply spray thoroughly to trunks, branches, and young leaves on bright clear days when the temperature is above 45° F., just before the start of the growing season.

During the summer period when foliage is present, use 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water and apply spray thoroughly to foliage and branches to control scale insects, whiteflies, mealybugs, and other insects, until not more than 3 applications have been made during the growing season.

**TO MIX**—Fill spray tank about one-third full with water, pour in the required amount of Superior Miscible Spray Oil, stir or agitate thoroughly and fill remainder of tank with water. Some agitation while spraying.

The dosage rate of 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water is equivalent to 1/2 pint per gallon.

Do not apply in freezing weather or when temperature is likely to drop to 32° F. or below. Do not apply to broadleaved evergreens when near-freezing temperatures are present during or immediately before hot, dry weather. Do not apply to plants within 30 days before or after application of sulphur.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE**—Keep away from sources of heat or flame. Do not store in unapproved containers. Do not store in unapproved disposal facility.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**—Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by other means.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**—Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or other reuse, if allowed by state and local authorities. Do not reuse for food or other uses.
