DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a ready-to-use powder to be applied without dilution or mixing.

GARDEN INSECTS—To control the insects named below on the crops listed, apply the dust thoroughly and uniformly (20 to 25 pounds of dust per acre) to cover upper and lower surfaces of foliage. Begin applications when insects first appear.

BEANS—Mexican bean beetle and bean leaf beetle.

CURCUBITS—Cucumber beetles.

TOMATOES, POTATOES, and EGGPLANTS — Potato beetles, flea beetles, aphids.

CABBAGE and RELATED CROPS—Cabbage caterpillars, flea beetles.

ASPARAGUS—Beetles.

CURRENTS, GOOSEBERRIES, RASPBERRIES—Fruit worms.

STRAWBERRIES—Spittlebug, leafroller.

Repeat applications at 7 to 10-day intervals as necessary.

DO NOT APPLY TO ABOVE NAMED CROPS WITHIN 1 DAY OF HARVEST.

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of dust. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs.

This product is poisonous to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Apply only for the purposes and in the manner directed in this label.
